Conclusion to PC Palace Suppliers:

PC Palace decided to continue with their support to Tshepo house of hope and "Senekal Jeugsorgsentrum" Senekal (Free State) this year, during our snuggle-in project. The temperature sometimes fall below 1 degree and the need for warm cloths and bedding are very big among these children, whose age's ranges between 1 and 16 years old.

PC Palace delivered heaters, warm water bottles, shoes, socks, blankets, duvets, sheets, jackets, soft toys and also a little treat for each child in the form of cookies, chips and sweets.

On the very cold morning of the 5th of June 2010, PC Palace visited the Tshepo house of hope. This is a childcare centre part of the Bophelo Multi-purpose Community Based Centre where 14 foster children with aids are being taken care of. The children got very excited when they saw all the gift bags. Each child received their own gift bag with presents. They immediately unpacked and looked with excitement at everything they got. We dressed the children with their new shoes and jackets. With mouths full of sweets and warm bodies you could see the joy on the little faces.

Later we visited the "Senekal Jeugsorgsentrum". Most of the children that were staying there last year were still there and they knew what was coming when they saw the people of PC Palace walking in with the parcels. Between the handing out of the parcels and catching up on what was happening in their lives the past year, some of the children started to decorate their rooms with the new duvets and gifts they got. They also received a radio with speakers and heaters for the house.

Without your support it wouldn't be possible to bring so much joy to these less privileged children. We definitely made a difference again this winter in the children's lives.
